Policy Statement

The goal of the Mosinee Youth Baseball organization is to provide a rewarding youth baseball program, while promoting positive life skills and strong character development. Our core values are fairness, respect, responsibility, trustworthiness and good citizenship. We strive for the highest standards of sportsmanship as detailed in the following Code of Conduct. Every participant; whether player, coach, parent or spectator, has a responsibility to comply with and enforce the provisions of the Code.

To accomplish these goals, each player, coach and parent (or guardian) must sign the Code of Conduct before any player can participate in the regular season games. By signing the Code of Conduct, each participant agrees to comply with the Code and acknowledges that any failure to comply with any provision of the Code could lead to disciplinary action.

Parent's Code of Conduct

Code of Conduct

Sanctions

1. If, in the sole judgment of an umpire or Mosinee Youth Baseball Board Member, an individual violates any provision of the MYB Code of Conduct, the umpire or MYB Board Member may either:
 - (a) Issue a verbal warning; or
 - (b) Issue a verbal warning and impose an “automatic out” penalty on the offending individual’s team; or
 - (c) If the conduct is sufficiently serious, eject the individual from the game and/or leave premise
2. If an individual receives a warning and then commits a second violation in the same game, the umpire or MYB Board Member will eject the individual from the game.
3. If an individual is ejected from the game, he or she will not be allowed to attend a MYB game for a period of one (1) week from the date of the ejection.
4. If an individual is ejected from the game a second time, he or she will be expelled from the MYB program and barred from attending MYB games for the remainder of the calendar year.

REVIEW

If an umpire or coach reports any violation of the Code of Conduct, a MYB Board Member will review the relevant facts and determine whether any further action (including sanctions) is appropriate.

VIOLATION: Taunting, ridiculing or arguing with an umpire, coach, player or spectator

1st OFFENSE: (a), (b) or (c)

2nd OFFENSE: Ejection from the game

VIOLATION: Using abusive or vulgar language

1st OFFENSE: (a), (b) or (c)

2nd OFFENSE: Ejection from the game

VIOLATION: Throwing bats, equipment or any other objects

1st OFFENSE: (a), (b) or (c)

2nd OFFENSE: Ejection from the game

VIOLATION: Engaging in disruptive or inappropriate behavior

1st OFFENSE: (a), (b) or (c)

2nd OFFENSE: Ejection from the game

VIOLATION: Conduct that endangers others

1st OFFENSE: Ejection from the game and/or program
