



To the Parents of Plumstead Baseball Association ("PBA"):

As the holiday season finishes up, the 2012 Plumstead Baseball's Registration will soon start. We will once again offer both walk-in and on-line registration options. Walk-in Registration will be held in the cafeteria at Tohickon Middle School from 7:00PM to 8:30PM on the following dates:

Monday, January 9, 2012
Wednesday, January 18, 2012
Thursday, January 26, 2012

Please visit our website, www.PlumsteadBaseball.org, to download the required registration forms for each player. On-line registration will be available starting January 1, 2012 and will officially close January 31, 2012. Register on-line at our website by clicking on the on-line registration link and follow the instructions. Mail-in registrations may be taken up to February 10, 2012; however, a \$25 late fee will be added to each player's registration fees received after January 31. Late fees are not capped by the family discount. Any registrations received after this date will only be accepted based on division availability.

Our programs include the Cal Ripken divisions for 5 - 12 year olds, Travel divisions for 8 - 15 year olds, senior divisions of ITL (13 - 18 year olds) and Connie Mack (13 - 17 year olds). Connie Mack baseball has increased its age limit to 17 starting in 2012. To participate in our travel programs, participants must register for an in-house program, i.e. Cal Ripken, ITL or Connie Mack. This requirement will be waived for those 13 – 15 year olds that make their middle or high-school school spring baseball team. Please visit our website for further information on the programs available.

We are looking forward to an exciting 2012 season and hope to accomplish much with your participation. The following volunteer opportunities need your time and talents:

- Coaches** – Head and Assistant Coaches – Head Coaches will be required to complete a separate application and training program

Parents of our participants in the 13 year old and above divisions are not required to volunteer (or pay the \$75 opt-out fee), but are encouraged to continue providing their time and talents wherever possible.
