



## SUN PRAIRIE LITTLE LEAGUE 2012 GENERAL INFORMATION GUIDE

### OVERVIEW

The Sun Prairie Little League is a volunteer non-profit organization chartered by Little League Baseball, Inc. Little League Baseball, Inc. is a program dedicated to helping youth develop qualities of citizenship, discipline, teamwork, and physical well-being. Players in the Sun Prairie Little League program must live within the boundaries of the Sun Prairie School District (SPASD).

### REGISTRATION

We prefer players register online at [www.spll.org](http://www.spll.org). Players can also print and send the registration form and fee to Sun Prairie Little League, P.O. Box 193, Sun Prairie, WI, 53590. A third alternative is to register at one of the following walk-up registration sessions at the Sun Prairie Public Library located at 1350 Linnerud Drive. Saturday, February 11 between 10 AM - 1 PM or Wednesday, February 15 between 6 PM - 8 PM.

What to bring to registration: completed registration form; health insurance policy name & number; your contact information; registration fee. You must register by **March 1st**. Failure to do so may result in a boy or girl not playing this summer. Late registrations will be accepted only if team rosters are not full and will be assessed a \$20 late fee per person.

### FAMILY DISCOUNT OPTIONS

Option 1: For families with two children playing please deduct \$20.00 from the total. For example, if a family has a child playing in the Minor and Major leagues the fee would be \$350.00 - \$20.00 (discount) for a total of \$330.00.

Option 2: For families with three or more children playing, pay the regular price of your oldest two children and all others are free. For example, if a family has a child playing in 3 different divisions they would pay the regular price of their two oldest children in the Major and Minor leagues and the Rookie league child would play for free. This family's fee would be \$175.00 + \$175.00 + \$0 for a total of \$350.00.

### UNIFORM SALES

The Sun Prairie Little League will continue to provide a shirt, cap, and socks to all registered players. The SPL is working with a uniform vendor to sell other uniform pieces and spirit-wear at *VERY COMPETITIVE PRICES!* Come to one of our walk-up registration sessions to see all the items for sale and try them on for size. Articles include baseball pants (gray recommended), belts, under-garments, and other fun items for the SPL fan in your family.

### SEASON DATES

Depending on your player's division, tryouts will be held on April 13, April 14, April 15, or April 21. See the tryout information sheet for details. The regular Little League season games, including the in-house tournaments, will run from April 28, 2012 through July 20, 2012. The Minor and Major baseball divisions are scheduled to start on April 28. Junior baseball is scheduled to start on May 7. Minor and Major softball is scheduled to begin the week of April 30. Junior softball will begin around the end of May and beginning of June. The Rookie baseball division is scheduled to begin on May 14. Please note that these dates are subject to change without notice if the number of players registering varies from our projections.

### INSURANCE

The Little League constitution requires that all players carry accidental medical insurance. The Little League insurance policy only supplements your regular insurance. Should your family insurance policy not fully cover the injury treatment, the Little League policy will help pay up to the limits in the policy. Should an injury occur, you should contact both your team coach and the Sun Prairie Little League President at 837-0011, as soon as possible.
